

Homewood Graduate Student and Postdoctoral Fellow Emergency Fund Application

Eligibility

- Only WSE (full and part-time) & KSAS (full-time only) graduate students (both masters and doctoral) and postdoctoral fellows may apply for funding. AAP and EP students are not eligible to apply at this time.
- Applicant must demonstrate extraordinary financial hardship resulting from an emergency, accident, or other severe unplanned event.
- Applicants must include documentation in support of their request (proof of emergency, all relevant financial documents (invoice/bill, etc.))
- Applicants must make an appointment with their cognizant Office of Graduate and Postdoctoral Affairs to discuss their application:

Important Notes

- 1. Emergency funds cannot be granted to reimburse expenses that have already been paid.
- 2. The following expenses are *typically* ineligible for emergency funds* (not an exhaustive list):

Tuition, fees, health insurance premiums, study abroad costs

Non-essential utilities (cable, etc.)

Furniture and/or household expenses not related to emergency damage or theft

Regularly anticipated expenses

Parking tickets, citiations, bail bonds

Costs for entertainment, recreation, non-emergency travel

- 3. All other resources, including emergency loans through financial aid, must have been considered and deemed to be insufficient, unavailable, or not accessible in timely manner; i.e. (credit card, payment plans, additional student aid, assistance from family/friends, personal fund options).
- 4. Applicants must complete all questions in full and submit supporting documentation.
- 5. Have not previously received Emergency Funds*

^{*}exceptions may be granted in the case of extraordinary circumstances at the discretion of the cogniznant graduate affairs office.
